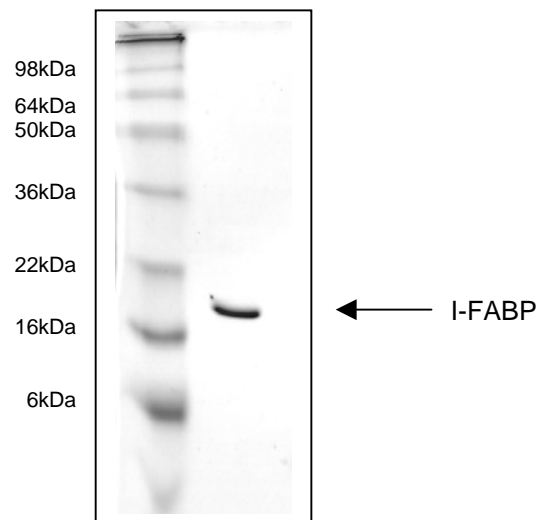
**Synonym:** Fatty Acid Binding Protein, Intestinal; FABP-2;

**Description:** Fatty acid binding proteins are a family of small, highly conserved, cytoplasmic proteins (14-15kDa) that bind long chain fatty acids, their CoA derivatives, bilirubin, organic anions and other small hydrophobic molecules. I-FABP (or FABP-2) is found predominantly in the intestine and is believed to be involved in the intestinal absorption of long chain fatty acids.

**RANDOX** recombinant L-FABP comprises a 132 amino acid fragment (1-132) corresponding to the human intestinal FABP protein and is expressed in *E. coli* with an amino-terminal hexahistidine tag. This product is for research use only and is not intended for diagnostic or therapeutic use.
