

Description

The process for recombinant Human BNIP3L protein synthesis in e.coli cells includes recombining the DNA fragment that encodes the Human BNIP3L protein (1-187aa) into expression vector, transforming the recombinant vector into e.coli cells, screening positive cells, cultivating and inducing cells, conducting cell lysis, and performing expression analysis. The resulting recombinant Human BNIP3L protein is purified from the cell lysate using affinity purification, with its purity exceeding 85% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Reconstitution

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Please reconstitute protein in deionized sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. We recommend to add 5-50% of glycerol (final concentration) and aliquot for long-term storage at -20°C/-80°C. Our default final concentration of glycerol is 50%. Customers could use it as reference.
