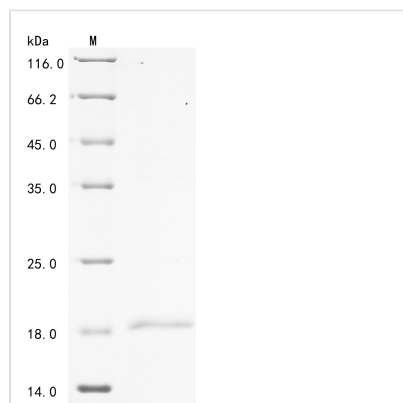

Description

The generation of the recombinant Pig PF4 protein involves transfecting e.coli cells with a DNA expression vector carrying the gene for the protein of interest (1-90aa). After transfection, the cells are cultured to express the desired protein. The protein is fused with a N-terminal 10xHis tag and C-terminal Myc tag. The recombinant Pig PF4 protein is collected and purified from the cell lysate through affinity purification, attaining a purity greater than 90%, as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Reconstitution

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Please reconstitute protein in deionized sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. We recommend to add 5-50% of glycerol (final concentration) and aliquot for long-term storage at -20°C/-80°C. Our default final concentration of glycerol is 50%. Customers could use it as reference.
