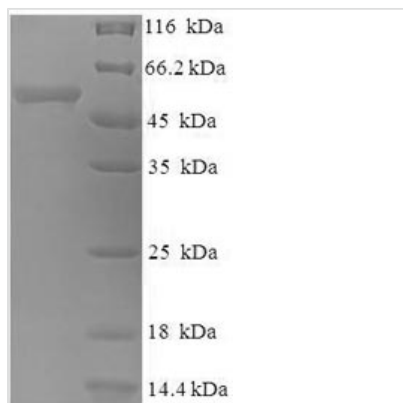




Recombinant Escherichia coli Hygromycin-B 4-O-kinase (hph)

Relevance	The aminoglycoside phosphotransferases achieve inactivation of their antibiotic substrates by phosphorylation. Only phosphorylates hygromycin and closely related compounds such as dethyl analogs and destomycin.
Abbreviation	Recombinant E.coli hph protein
Storage	The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at -20°C/-80°C. The shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20°C/-80°C.

Reconstitution

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Please reconstitute protein in deionized sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. We recommend to add 5-50% of glycerol (final concentration) and aliquot for long-term storage at -20°C/-80°C. Our default final concentration of glycerol is 50%. Customers could use it as reference.
