





# Recombinant Mouse Inositol 1,4,5-trisphosphate receptor-interacting protein-like 1 (Itpripl1), partial (Active)

<b>Storage</b>	The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at -20°C/-80°C. The shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20°C/-80°C.

#### Activity

Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. Immobilized Mouse Itpr1l1 at 2  $\mu$ g/ml can bind Anti-ITPR1L1 recombinant antibody (CSB-RA756966MA1HU). The EC<sub>50</sub> is 0.7534-0.9877 ng/mL.

#### Endotoxin

Less than 1.0 EU/ug as determined by LAL method.

#### Reconstitution

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Please reconstitute protein in deionized sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. We recommend to add 5-50% of glycerol (final concentration) and aliquot for long-term storage at -20°C/-80°C. Our default final concentration of glycerol is 50%. Customers could use it as reference.

#### Shelf Life
