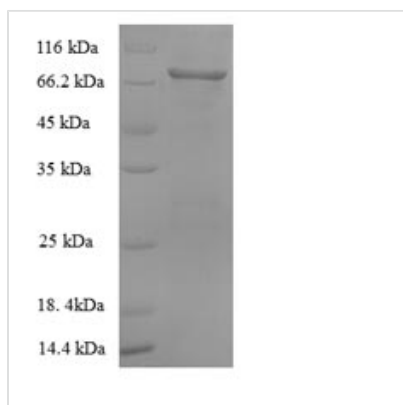




Recombinant *Macaca fascicularis* albumin (ALB)

Relevance	Serum albumin, the main protein of plasma, has a good binding capacity for water, Ca ²⁺ , Na ⁺ , K ⁺ , fatty acids, hormones, bilirubin and drugs. Its main function is the regulation of the colloidal osmotic pressure of blood. Major zinc transporter in plasma, typically binds about 80% of all plasma zinc.
Abbreviation	Recombinant Cynomolgus monkey ALB protein
Storage	The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at -20°C/-80°C. The shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20°C/-80°C.
